

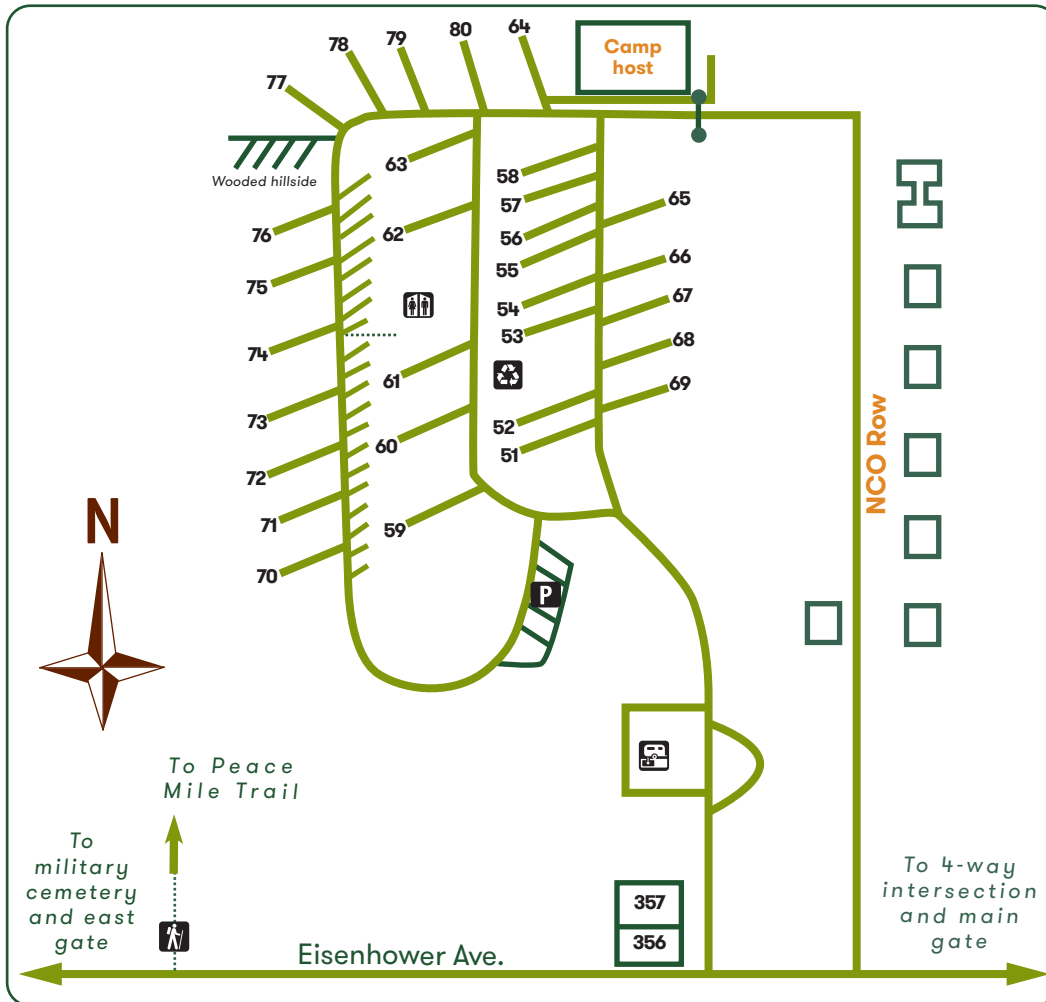

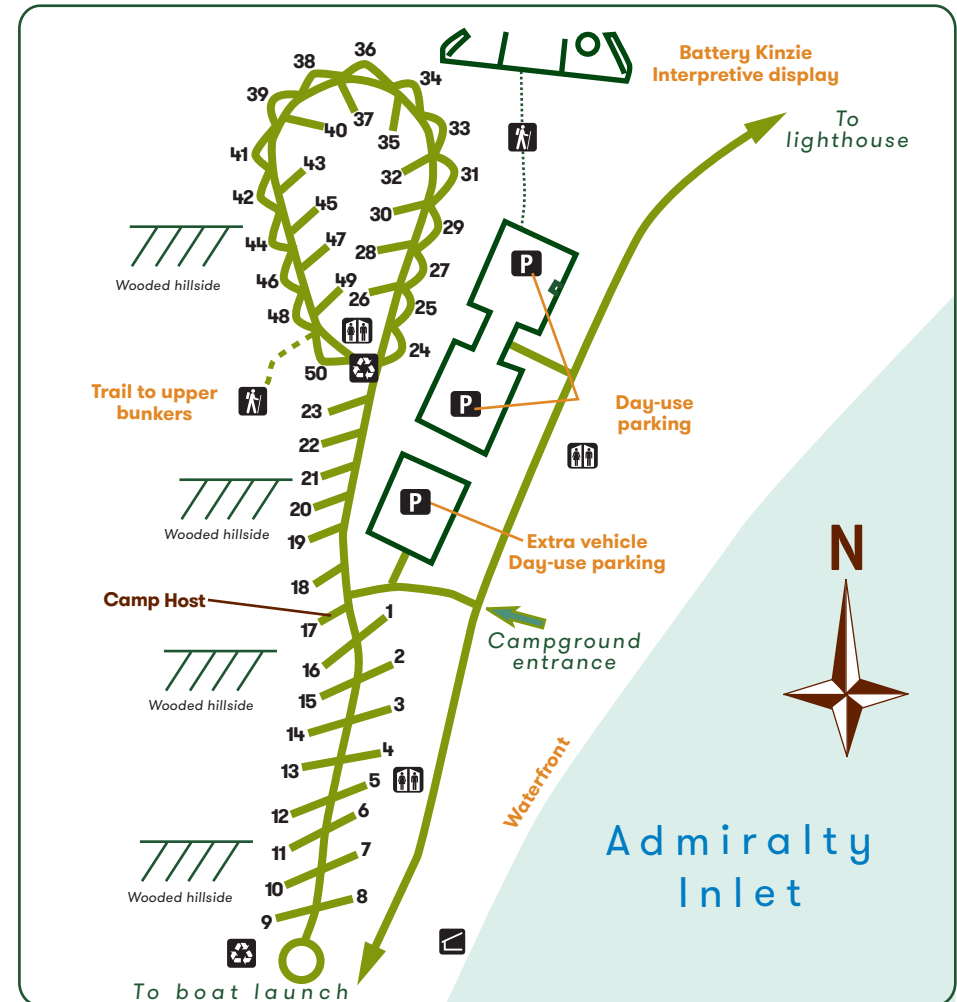
UPPER FOREST CAMPGROUND

CAMPING INFORMATION

Summer Rates: \$35-\$50/site

Winter Rates: \$30-\$45/site

**Rates vary depending on the site*

BEACH CAMPGROUND:

Sites 1-50 are full hook-up
(water, electricity and sewer)

UPPER FOREST CAMPGROUND:

(Closed seasonally November-February)

Sites 51-80 are partial hook-up
(electricity and water)

Dump station at camp entrance.

COMMON PARK RULES

- The park closes at dusk. Visiting hours end at 10:00 p.m. (WAC 352-32-050[1])
- All vehicles must be parked in a designated parking area.
No parking on the grass. (WAC 352-20-010)
- No gathering firewood or driftwood. (WAC 352-32-290[7])
- Pets must always be on a leash. (WAC 352-32-060[1])
- All fires must be in the approved fire pits. No beach fires. (WAC 352-32-125)
- Only one RV/camping unit (e.g., trailers) per campsite. (WAC 352-32-030[8])
- Secure all valuables whenever you leave your site or vehicle.
- Consume alcohol only in designated campsites, event venues and picnic areas. (WAC 352-32-210[1])
- It is illegal to be intoxicated in a state park. (WAC 352-32-220)
- Do not feed the wildlife. (WAC 352-32-01001)
- For your own safety, do not harass or approach the wildlife.
The deer may appear tame, but they are still wild animals.
