Revenue from Discover Pass replaces general fund tax funding no longer available to cover the cost of operations.



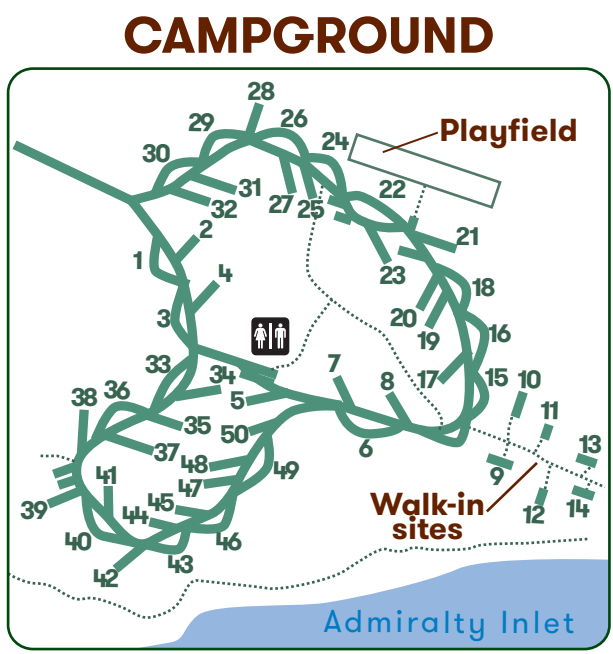
