Bay View State Park	In progress		Park-wide wastewater treatment upgrade.
Belfair State Park	Complete	Complete	Added a pre-treatment system to existing wastewater treatment system and upgrade utility hookup sites in campground.
Belfair State Park	Complete	Complete	Storm water management using Low Impact Development techniques.
Birch Bay State Park	Complete	Complete	This project replaced beach area sewer lift station pumps and improved connection to the municipal sewer by replacing valves and manholes.
Blake Island State Park	Complete	Complete	This project will bring the sewage collection and treatment system into compliance. The domestic water system will be upgraded in the process.
Camano Island State Park	Complete	Complete	This project replaced outdated sewage collection and treatment system at park office, shop and residence. Repairs to the campground drainfield occurred as well.
Dash Point State Park	Complete	Currently Under Construction	This project replaced the park-wide wastewater collection system and connects the entire park wastewater system to the Lakehaven treatment facility.
Deception Pass State Park	Complete	Complete	This project replaced outdated sewage collection and treatment system in the Cornet Bay area of the park with a connection to the sewage treatment system at the Naval Base.
Dosewallips State Park	In progress	Ph 1 Under Construction	Replace wastewater collection and treatment system. Upgrade existing comfort stations. (to be constructed on recently acquired property in the Brinnon area)
Fay Bainbridge State Park	Complete		Replace outdated and fragmented sewage collection and treatment systems with a new MBR system along with repair/replacement of the day use restroom. (If funded, system will have increased capability to allow additional flows from neighboring community)
Ft Casey State Park	Complete	Complete	This project replaced collection system and drainfield and supplement replacement of 80 year old restroom. It also connected Lighthouse facilities into new treatment system.
Ft Ebey State Park	Complete	Complete	The project will replace a failing pressurized dome drainfield as well as the upgrade of the collection system.
Ft Flagler State Park	Complete	Complete	Using MBR technology, replaced fragmented systems into one park-wide wastewater treatment facility.
Fort Worden State Park	Complete	Currently Under Construction	Replace sewage pumps in two sewage lift stations in the beach area. Construct a permeable pavement parking area for Bldg 246.
Illahee State Park	Complete	Currently Under Construction	Replace outdated and fragmented sewage collection and treatment systems with a new MBR system.
Kitsap Memorial State Park	Complete	Pilot Program Complete	Renovate RV dump station and drainfield with pilot MBR system for 2008 summer use season and assess current park-wide systems.
Kopachuck State Park	On hold pending additional funding to support partner system		Replace outdated and fragmented sewage collection and treatment systems with a new treatment system. (looking at possibly an MBR and having Peninsula School District tie into the park system)
Larrabee State Park	Complete	Complete	This project replaced the 30 year old park wide wastewater collection and treatment system with an MBR.
Penrose State Park	Complete		This project will replace outdated sewage collection and treatment systems with a single consolidated system along with upgrade of restroom facilities.
Pleasant Harbor State Park	Complete	Complete	Added a new vault toilet and improved parking lot stormwater management.
Possession Point State Park	Complete	In progress	This project replaced an outdated sewage collection and treatment systems with a single consolidated system along with upgrade of restroom facilities and parking lot. A storm water diverter system will be added above the drainfield to limit flooding.
Potlatch State Park	Complete	Currently Under Construction	Connect parkwide sewer system with Minerva Beach treatment system or add an MBR plant. Improve storm water management system. If possible, move park housing away from salmon bearing stream.
Saltwater State Park	Complete	Complete	Storm water management using Low Impact Development techniques.
Sequim Bay State Park	Complete	Complete	This project replaced the park-wide wastewater collection system and connected the entire park wastewater system to the City of Sequim municipal sewer and treatment facility.
Scenic Beach State Park	Complete	Complete	Assessed the 30+ year old wastewater collection and treatment system and constructed a small on-site system for the Emel House.
Shine Tidelands/Wolfe Property	In progress		Add new comfort station, parking lot and stormwater management.
Triton Cove State Park	Complete	Complete	Improved parking lot stormwater management.
Twanoh State Park	Complete	Complete	Replaced entire wastewater collection & treatment system.
