

Cape Disappointment State Park – North Head Light House Roof Residence Replacement

This project consisted of replacement of the copper roof and roofing framing on the North Head Lighthouse Residence.

Need: The copper roof at The North Head Light Keepers house is over 100 years old. The roof leaks and has caused the wooden framing to rot. Not replacing the roof will allow the rot to continue and eventually the building will fail.
