

Columbia Hills State Park – Comfort Station Replacement

This project consisted of the demolition of an existing comfort station, construction of a new comfort station, installation/replacement of underground utilities, construction of a pressurized drainfield system, site restoration, and other associated items of work.

Need: The existing restroom was built in 1962 and has met its life expectancy. It is too small for weekend capacities and does not meet ADA accessibility requirements.
