

Curlew Lake State Park Comfort Station Replacement

This project consisted of a new comfort station, installation/replacement of underground utilities, construction of a pressurized drain field system, the demolition of an existing comfort station, and site restoration.

Need: This comfort station had no shower facilities, and park users had to walk over a quarter of a mile to shower at another location. This distance and the condition of the outmoded facility were in violation of ADA accessibility regulations. This underserved region of the state views this park as an important economic resource but facility conditions discourages camper use. The septic system is located in the pipe chase and is within 50' of park well which is out of compliance with Department of Health wellhead protection rules.
