

Joemma Beach State Park – Marine Facility Renovation

This project included construction of a standard parks boat launch pier and handling floats for an existing concrete boat launch ramp.

Need: The mooring floats were failing, and there needed to be a more stable launch and moorage facility in a high wind area.
