

Pearrygin Lake Sno-Park Winter Grooming Report

December 25, 2024

The Pearrygin Lake Sno-Park winter trails are provided through a partnership between the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission, the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife, and the dedicated trail groomers of Methow Fatbike. Please respect their time and efforts by being courteous to other trail users, respecting the conditions of use for this trail system, and respecting trail use designations and closures. Enjoy!

Merry Christmas to all. With the cooler temps and some hard work, the grooming crew was able to groom all of the trails in both campgrounds, Fours, the Rex Derr trail, Meanderthal, and the lower part of Marsh-up last night. Other trails will still have loose fresh snow on top of them and may be difficult to ride. Please be mindful and drop your tire pressure or choose other trails if leaving tracks deeper than 1" in the groomed surface. Lloyd Ranch still has not been groomed since the big storm and likely won't be until we can get the state park trails back up to snuff.

Don't forget, a Washington State Sno-Park permit is required to park in any of the three trailhead parking lots located in Pearrygin Lake State Park and makes this trail system possible. No trail pass is required to use the trails, only for parking. The Sno-Park funds pay for the plowing of trailhead parking, grooming equipment and maintenance, grooming staff, and fuel for the snowmobiles we use for grooming. Sno-Park Permits can be purchased at Partners Mini-Mart, Methow Cycle & Sport, Goats Beard Mountain Supplies, and Winthrop Mountain Sports.
