KEYNOTE SPEAKER

COMMISSIONER SOPHIA DANENBERG

Sophia Danenberg is a rock, ice and mountain climber who has climbed mountains across the globe—from the



Matterhorn and Chamonix in the Alps to Kilimanjaro and Mount Kenya in Africa to Aconcagua in South America. In 2006, she made history by becoming the first black woman and the first black American to summit Mount Everest. She is a Washington State Parks and Recreation Commissioner and volunteers on the board of NatureBridge, an environmental education non-profit operating in national parks. She is also very active in her union, currently serving on the state and national Legislative & Public Affairs committees for the Society of Professional Engineering Employees in Aerospace (SPEEA.)

Professionally, Sophia is an Associate Technical Fellow for international environmental policy at Boeing, primarily focusing on chemicals and waste policy. In this role, she represents the company on multiple trade associations and interfaces with global organizations such as the European Union, Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation and various UN multilateral conventions on behalf of the aerospace and defense industry. Before starting her career, Sophia was a researcher-writer for a travel guide in Thailand and Laos and a Fulbright Fellow at Keio University in Tokyo. She graduated magna cum laude from Harvard University in environmental sciences and public policy and completed graduate coursework in environmental economics and law at the University of Connecticut.

Cowlitz Indian Tribe Chairman William (Bill) Iyall, P.E., first served as Cowlitz Chairman in 2008 and was subsequently re-elected for four consecutive



terms until his initial retirement in 2020. Under Chairman lyall's leadership, the Tribe established their reservation in Ridgefield, WA in 2015 and eventually opened their Casino Resort, ilani, in 2017.

In 2024, Chairman Iyall was re-elected for his second stint as Cowlitz Chairman and he looks forward to leading the Tribe again on a course toward deepened prosperity, economic opportunity and self-determination. Chairman Iyall received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from St. Martin's University and was named Saint Martin's University Distinguished Alumni for Professional Achievement in 2022. He is also United States Army Veteran and worked as a licensed Professional Engineer for the city of Tacoma's Public Works and Public Utility Departments for 35 years.

In his spare time, you can find him enjoying the beauty of the Pacific Northwest through fishing, biking and hiking.


