



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GENERAL PROJECT NOTES:

- 1. ALL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PROJECT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- 2. APPROVAL OF THIS ROAD, GRADING, PARKING AND DRAINAGE PLAN DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN APPROVAL OF ANY OTHER CONSTRUCTION (E.G. DOMESTIC WATER CONVEYANCE, SEWER CONVEYANCE, GAS, ELECTRICAL, ETC.).
- 3. BEFORE ANY CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY, A PRECONSTRUCTION MEETING MUST BE HELD BETWEEN THE CONTRACTOR, CIVIL ENGINEER, AND WASHINGTON STATE PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION (WSPRC).

- 6. IT SHALL BE THE APPLICANT'S/CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO OBTAIN ALL CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS NECESSARY BEFORE INITIATING OFF-SITE WORK. EASEMENTS REQUIRE REVIEW AND APPROVAL PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
- 7. TEMPORARY EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL NOTES:

- 1. APPROVAL OF THIS EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL (ESC) PLAN DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN APPROVAL OF PERMANENT ROAD OR DRAINAGE DESIGN (E.G. SIZE AND LOCATION OF ROADS, PIPES, RESTRICTORS, CHANNELS, RETENTION FACILITIES, UTILITIES, ETC.)
- 2. THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THESE ESC PLANS AND THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, REPLACEMENT, AND UPGRADING OF THESE ESC FACILITIES IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ESC SUPERVISOR, PROVIDED BY THE CONTRACTOR, UNTIL ALL CONSTRUCTION IS APPROVED.

- 8. ANY AREAS OF EXPOSED SOILS, INCLUDING ROADWAY EMBANKMENTS, THAT WILL NOT BE DISTURBED FOR TWO DAYS DURING THE WET SEASON OR SEVEN DAYS DURING THE DRY SEASON SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY STABILIZED WITH THE APPROVED ESC COVER METHODS (E.G., SEEDING, MULCHING, PLASTIC COVERING, ETC.).
- 9. ANY AREA NEEDING ESC MEASURES, NOT REQUIRING IMMEDIATE ATTENTION, SHALL BE ADDRESSED WITHIN SEVEN DAYS.
- 10. THE ESC FACILITIES ON INACTIVE SITES SHALL BE INSPECTED AND MAINTAINED A MINIMUM OF ONCE A MONTH (MORE FREQUENTLY AS REQUIRED BY THE ESC SUPERVISOR) OR WITHIN 24 HOURS FOLLOWING A STORM EVENT.
- 11. ALL CONVEYANCE LINES SHALL BE CLEANED PRIOR TO LINING. THE CLEANING OPERATION SHALL NOT FLUSH SEDIMENT-LADEN WATER INTO THE DOWNSTREAM SYSTEM.
- 12. PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE WET SEASON (OCT. 1), ALL DISTURBED AREAS SHALL BE REVIEWED TO IDENTIFY WHICH ONES CAN BE SEEDED IN PREPARATION FOR THE WINTER RAINS. DISTURBED AREAS SHALL BE SEEDED WITHIN ONE WEEK OF THE BEGINNING OF THE WET SEASON.

- 1. SITE SOIL EXCAVATIONS MUST BE IMMEDIATELY BACKFILLED TO REDUCE THE POTENTIAL FOR TRENCH DEGRADATION DUE TO WATER INFILTRATION. SUB-SUBGRADED AREAS SHALL BE EXCAVATED TO THE LINES SHOWN HEREIN.
- 2. PERFORM SITE STRIPPING IN AREAS WHERE TREE ROOTS ARE FOUND UNDER AREAS OF PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS.





PREFERRED CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE

THE CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE IS THE CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITY, THIS PREFERRED CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE LISTED BELOW IDENTIFIES STEPS TO MEET ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A REVISED CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE/PROJECT SCHEDULE TO THE PROJECT ENGINEER AND OWNER FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL PRIOR TO THE OCCURRENCE OF WORK.

- 1. COORDINATE WITH WSPRC, PROJECT ENGINEER AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATOR ON PARK CLOSURE OPERATIONS.
- 2. INSTALL TRAFFIC CONTROL MEASURES.
- 3. SITE MOBILIZATION.
- 4. ESTABLISH AND FLAG STAGING AREAS PER NOTE 5 BELOW. NOTIFY WSPRC, PROJECT ENGINEER, AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATOR WHEN AREAS ARE FLAGGED FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL.
- 5. INSTALL TESC MEASURES:

ESTABLISH PARK ENTRANCE TESC BMPS TO KEEP HUME ROAD FREE OF SEDIMENT AND DEBRIS.

FLAG CLEARING LIMITS AT INTERPRETIVE PARKING LOT, CULVERT REPAIR/REPLACEMENT AREAS, THE LOWER AND UPPER SUMMIT PARKING LOTS, PLANTING AREAS, AND LOCATION OF GUARDRAIL INSTALLATION NOT LESS THAN 6 WEEKS PRIOR TO SCHEDULED GROUND DISTURBING ACTIVITIES. CLEAR AND GRUB PER PLAN.

REMOVE VEGETATION WITHIN VEGETATION CLEARING AREAS AS DETERMINED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER.

INSTALL TOP SOIL AND NEW VEGETATION AT LOWER SUMMIT PARKING LOT (BID ALT NO. A4, IF APPROVED).









SETTLEMENT AREA #2 TESC & DEMO PLAN









CEMENT CONCRETE SIDEWALK DETAIL SCALE: NTS
