

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Park hours are 8 a.m. to dusk.
- Seasonal schedule: For a seasonal schedule and information about seasonal closures, call the Blue Mountain Area Headquarters 509-337-6457 or visit parks.wa.gov.
- Wildlife, plants and all park buildings, signs, tables and other structures are protected; removal or damage of any kind is prohibited. Hunting, feeding of wildlife and gathering firewood on state park property is prohibited.
- The boat launch fee is \$7 and is in addition to the Discover Pass.
- Pets must be on leash and under physical control at all times. This includes trail areas and all park grounds. Pet owners must clean up after pets on all state park lands.

Lyons Ferry is a 168-acre park situated at the confluence of the Palouse and Snake rivers. The park has more than 5,200 feet of shoreline and offers a variety of activities, including boating, fishing, hiking and swimming. The park is open for day use only and offers picnic tables, a swimming beach, boat launch and restrooms with showers.
