Subject: Miller Peninsula State Park Development

We are writing to you as concerned citizens of Washington State and residents of Diamond Point in Clallam County, the location of the proposed development of the Miller Peninsula State Park. We do not support the development of this state property for a number of safety and environmental reasons set forth below.

Access: Diamond Point is a residential community located in the Northeast corner of the Miller Peninsula surrounded on the north and east by salt water and on the south and west by the state owned Miller Peninsula State Park property. The community of 700+ homes is at the terminus of the three mile long two lane Diamond Point Road, the only access and egress available for the people who live here. The road intersects State Highway 101 and winds its way through forest to the community. This is often a busy road supporting the community's day to day access. Highway 101 is a heavily used artery serving the entire northern Olympic Peninsula with population centers west of Diamond Point Road. The Diamond Point Road intersection at 101 is already dangerous and difficult to transit with the current traffic load and is compounded during high season. Increased usage of the state park property, including large RV's, will add significantly more traffic to this small roadway and busy intersection and would present a major increase in the danger to the residents and park users. Neither a traffic light or a traffic circle would solve this access problem without negative consequences to the traffic on Highway 101. A serious traffic study including alternative access proposals and solutions should be conducted before advancing the ideas of a park development further.

Water: Reliable supply of potable water is crucial to the future of the Diamond Point community. The Miller Peninsula is surrounded by salt water on three sides. The aquifers underlying the peninsula currently provide quality drinking water to the community and exist at approximately the same depth as mean sea level, inviting the specter of seawater intrusion. Our community considers it risky to add a large water consumer such as a developed state park to this already limited resource without a comprehensive study of the long term viability of the aquifer. Waste water treatment and storm water management are also of significant concern to this community due to their potential to damage the environment and pollute groundwater. Proceeding with park development plans and proposals without a detailed water study up front is rash and potentially a waste of taxpayer funds.

Fire: It cannot be overstated how the risk of fire danger has increased over the last few years. Diamond Point has a volunteer fire department and 700 homes to protect. The firewater system in the community is already inadequate. Many residents are elderly and mobility challenged. Adding camping and campfires to the forest surrounding the community adds appreciably to fire

danger to the residents, particularly in view of the limited and single route egress from the community to safety. Wind direction in the dry season is generally from the west placing the community in the path of fires that originate in the park property. Evacuation of people from 700 homes would be more difficult if the road is full of large RVs also trying to escape at the same time.

Environmental considerations: The forest contained in Miller State Park is a rich environment of healthy trees, providing much needed oxygen and carbon absorption. Our climate is changing and the world we have all grown up in is no longer as it once was. Our state leadership has clearly recognized and propounded the need to curb climate change. Removing healthy carbon absorbing trees in Miller State Park to make room for large fossil fuel guzzling, carbon emitting RV's just does not make any sense in view of the above. Ecology's SEPA guidance says that Greenhouse gas emissions are considered an air pollutant and may need to be addressed.

SEPA: The seriousness of these concerns to our community are confirmed by over 500 signatures on a petition circulated around the Diamond Point community. There is a critical need for a full, comprehensive and timely State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) process including an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). Our community expectations are for an objective consideration of a lower impact development alternative as well as the required "no action" alternative [see WAC 197-11-440(5)(b)(ii)]. There should not be any short cutting of this process, no utilization of old potentially out of date investigative work or waiving of any of the SEPA requirements. We do not believe that this project should qualify for a Declaration of Non Significance (DNS) or Mitigated DNS due to the large number of impacts that are anticipated. Times have changed in the last 20 years.

As residents of Diamond Point, we respectfully request that the State Parks and Recreation Commission adopt the "no action" alternative and maintain the Miller Peninsula State Park property as a natural recreational area with the least impact on wildlife habitats. Maintaining the park in its natural state is best for the trees and wildlife while maintaining accessibility for all people of this state to use for healthy low impact hiking, biking and equestrian purposes. We explicitly request to be notified of the commencement of any phase of action relating to the proposal, including SEPA required notices for scoping, publication of documents, and public comment opportunities including meetings and hearings.
